Refugees can request a special dietary allowance of \$75/month (per family) if they provide a doctor or nurse practitioner's note indicating they have a medical condition requiring a specialized diet. If the RAP file is still open at time of receipt, no retroactive payments will be made.

A National Housing Supplement of up to \$200 may be available for Government Assisted Refugees and is assessed based on actual rent/utilities amounts. The Resettlement Assistance Program provides the support above to Government Assisted Refugees for the first 12 months after arriving in Canada.

CANADA CHILD BENEFIT MONTHLY PAYMENT ESTIMATES AS OF JUL 2018

\$541 per month for each eligible child under the age of 6
\$457 per month for each eligible child aged 6 to 17
* These amounts start being reduced when the adjusted family net income is over \$30,450

Example: A couple house hold with three children (age 2, 4, and 7) could receive up to \$3,176 per month while in receipt of Ontario Works

\$1,309 through Ontario Works

\$351 through Ontario Child Benefit

\$1,539 through Canada Child Benefit (\$1,082 for the children under 6, and \$457 for the child over 6)
