- > Take Canadian Language Benchmarks (CLB) levels 3 to 6 courses, depending on your schedule
- > Receive support from a specialized tutor
- > Have your language proficiency levels evaluated remotely for placement in the program
- > Receive one-on-one guidance to set goals towards further education or a sustainable career

To register, you must:

- > Be a permanent resident, convention refugee or protected person, a Ukrainian temporary resident or their dependent in Canada; live in Ontario
- > Be 18 years or older
- > Have a minimum language proficiency level of CLB 2 in French or English

French as a Second language.

The French language training program is divided into 10 courses designed to enable you to learn French quickly. While each course stands alone, the levels provide you with a building block approach to learning the language easily. After successful completion of the program, you will receive a Collège Boréal French as a Second Language certificate.

Beginner Level - 15 weeks (x3 levels)

Learn the basics of the French language and use the most common expressions in everyday living.

Intermediate Level - 15 weeks (x3 levels)

At the end of this level you will be able to participate in almost any conversation and write complex sentences.

Advanced Level - 15 weeks (x3 levels)

Journey towards fluency. At the end of this level you will think, speak and write in French.
